GENERAL GUIDELINES

- You are permitted to sell/exhibit within the space you purchase. **Absolutely no roaming sales are allowed!** Anyone found selling outside of their purchased space will forfeit their space and will no longer be eligible for vending space at future I-70 MSP events.
- Space assignments are subject to change anytime.
- All vehicles must have proof of insurance inside the midway area.
- Anyone selling unauthorized items will be removed from the grounds. All items must be approved prior to acceptance.
- I-70 MSP will not allow any items i.e., flags, t-shirts, bandanas, novelty items, to be sold or promoted that reference illegal activities, violence, profanity, nudity, or discrimination. This is a no tolerance policy. I-70 MSP reserves the right to remove from the grounds, any exhibitor breaching this policy and will result in permanent termination from displaying at any future I-70 MSP events.
- Any usage of any type of noise-making devices, flashing lights, etc. must have prior approval by I-70 MSP staff.
- Any exhibitors expecting UPS or FedEx shipments must be on-site to accept packages in their name. I-70 MSP will not be responsible for accepting shipments.
- Vendors are responsible for any injuries involved with setting up, tearing down, or to its patrons while on I-70 MSP Property.
- No unauthorized sweepstakes or trip registration allowed.
- Security is provided on a 24-hour basis; however, I-70 MSP does not assume responsibility for any stolen or damaged items. ABSOLUTELY NO PERSONS will be allowed in the midway area once the events have concluded. (Harvest Fest Only)

TEARDOWN

You may begin teardown once the feature events begin. (15 minutes after the show closing on Sunday for Harvest Fest) Absolutely no vehicles will be able to access the site for teardown until patrons have cleared the midway Sunday evening. All booths must be dismantled and removed from the property at the conclusion of all activities on race night, (Final day of Harvest Fest.) Please bag all trash and place it on the road for removal. Leave your space clean and as you received it.

• No early teardowns allowed (for Harvest Fest) Booths will open and close corresponding with the festival hours Exhibitors are required to stay open until the last act each day.
